#### Ann's handy hints for bunnies

If your rabbit stops eating this can be extremely dangerous and must be addressed immediately. Offer your rabbit fresh parsley (slightly crushed to release the scent) grass and dandelion leaves (also slightly crushed) Dandelions might make your rabbit wee more but don't worry. Make sure they have plenty of water. If there is no improvement you must contact a vet as loss of appetite can lead to gastro intestinal stasis which is life threatening!
