At Animal Care we are seeing more and more cruelty cases each year, and are being asked to help the RSPCA on a regular basis.

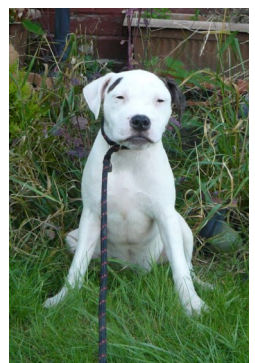
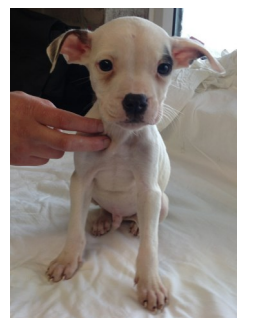
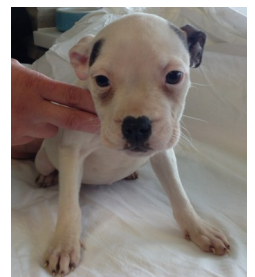
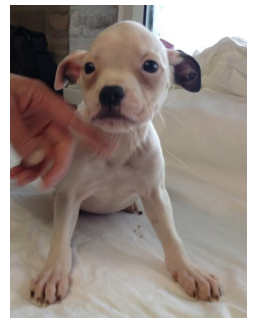
Unfortunately, many people are using the internet to buy and sell animals as if they were commodities. Private sellers, unlicensed breeders, and people who just allow their animals to breed indiscriminately are all contributing towards the increasing problem in this country of unwanted and abandoned pets. Rescue centres are bursting at the seams and struggling to cope.

This June we took in 8 boxer cross puppies and their mother, all seriously ill due to starvation. Sadly we were too late to save one of them but the other 7 have done very well, thanks to our fantastic foster mum Julie who took on the challenge of getting 7 very sick puppies back to full health. 5 of these pups have now found amazing homes and 2 are still waiting.

Look at them now!

Julie works incredibly hard and has helped us find over 70 pups new homes. All these little mouths to feed can cost the charity a lot of money. If you ever want to donate food to us please donate puppy food.
